Bank Robberies

111-0208 / 30 minutes

Because 2006 was a record-breaking year for bank robberies, there is a need to re-educate and in some cases educate law enforcement on what to do should a bank robbery occur. In this course, law enforcement officers will learn how banks train their tellers, the bank procedures for bank robberies, and the IACP Bank Alarm Response policy.



Roll Call: Concealed Carry Tactics for Off-Duty and Plainclothes Officers

057-0208 / 30 minutes

Whether working plainclothes, undercover, or carrying off duty, police officers who are carrying firearms concealed on a daily basis must have a solid understanding of the concepts of concealment and the tactics that are practical when deploying a handgun from concealment. Through a systematic methodology, officers will be exposed to new skills.



Terrorist Preparedness: Critical Incident Management

This is the first in a series of training courses developed to assist the first responders of Montgomery County prepare for critical incidents. This course illustrates the Montgomery County Incident Management System, explaining how the Montgomery County system supports the National Incident Management System, as prescribed by Presidential Directive. The Montgomery County example can be adapted and applied in most regions.



Roll Call: The Schertz, Texas, Shootout

A stretch of interstate in Schertz, Texas, was the site of a dramatic roadside shootout, when an assailant used an AK-47 assault rifle and a handgun to open fire on Officer Richard Kunz during a traffic stop. In this edition of Roll Call, Officer Kunz recounts the events of that night and talks about the training that saved his life.



Tactical Thinking: Traffic Stops

Tactical thinking education and drills provide officers a safe environment in which to think critically through scenarios. Practicing tactical thinking is essential to officer safety and provides experiences for the officer to draw upon during a real-life situation. This course discusses tactical thinking and how it relates to the procedures for conducting a traffic stop. Traffic stops may be a routine procedure, but officers should never treat them as such.

Traffic Stops and Racial Profiling: Officer-Motorist Interaction

Traffic stops are among the most common interactions between the public and the police. Unfair and illegal practices such as discriminatory profiling can have a major negative impact on the public perceptions of law enforcement. In this course, we identify methods to more effectively communicate with the public during traffic stops and identify ways to minimize conflict and maximize cooperation.



GIS: Providing the Foundation for Real-Time Intelligence, Part 1

405-0706 / 30 minutes

Imagine having the floor plan of a large bank at the fingertips of law enforcement officers before responding to a robbery, the most direct route for firefighters to a wildfire, or a graphical representation of the most likely terrorist targets within a given geographical radius. Sound like science fiction? Not anymore. Geographic information system (GIS) technology provides first responders with real-time intelligence data in the form of maps, floor plans, photographs, and much more. Join us as we explain the basics of how this new technology works. This course also profiles Wilson, N.C., a growing city that has implemented GIS technology to make quicker, more informed decisions about how to prepare and respond to disasters.



Med Aid: Poison Exposure Hazards

040-0010 / 30 minutes

In the air, on the ground, at work, or at home, everywhere we turn there are possible poison exposure hazards. In this course, we examine the differences between toxic and non-toxic substances and look at the benefits of utilizing poison control centers.



Violent Offenders Analysis, Part 6:

Dangerousness

179-0123 / 30 minutes

You can't judge a book by its cover, and you often can't judge a violent offender by his or her appearance. There are, however, things that will help indicate the dangerousness of an individual. In this course, FBI SSA Alan Brantley outlines a user-friendly guide for identifying potential offenders.



Crime Scene Response

184-0013 / 30 minutes

A conviction begins at the crime scene investigation. This activity covers the responsibilities of the investigator upon arrival.



Weapons of Mass Destruction:

What Every Officer Should Know, Part 1

162-0010 / 30 minutes

This course provides the officer with a context in which to understand weapons of mass destruction (WMD). The majority of U.S. police officers work in suburban and rural settings and may be likely to view WMD as a predominantly urban threat. This course helps these officers see how WMD impact the safety of their communities. It introduces the series and provides a general overview of the types and effects of the five major categories of WMD.

Mission Critical: A Revolution in First Response

047-0214 / 30 minutes

First responders are our nation's first line of defense against terrorist threats and threats against public safety. The topics covered in this program are: improving interoperable communications, improving situational awareness and security during a crisis such as campus shootings, identifying suspicious white powders in a more accurate and speedy manner for the Hazmat community, and finally how the adoption of a common identity platform for all of our Nation's first responders and support players, such as telecomm, utilities and DOTs, will improve response time and their ability to restore civil order.
