The presence of a police officer on the scene is the first level of the use of force. The officer must project confidence and control before he speaks his first word to the subject. "Command presence" is the subject's perception that the officer is capable of handling any situation that comes his way. Command presence is conveyed not only by such physical characteristics as stance, attitude, and the way an officer "carries" himself, but also by his professional appearance — which includes shined shoes

and a pressed uniform. Command presence is important: It is the first step in keeping an officer alive.
