This program examines tactical thinking as it relates to the environmental safety of officers during traffic stops. The purpose, composition, and focus of LESS will be emphasized.

A+ The presence of a police officer on the scene is the first level of the use of force. The officer must project confidence and control before he speaks his first word to the subject. Command presence is the subject's perception that the officer is capable of handling any situation that comes his way. Command presence is conveyed not only by such bearing as stance, attitude, and the way an officer "carries" himself, but also by his professional appearance, which includes shined shoes and a pressed uniform. Command presence is important: It is the first step in keeping an officer alive.

A+ Drug raids are among the most dangerous operations that you will undertake as a law enforcement officer. Preparation and planning are essential for a successful and safe raid. This program takes an in-depth look at how to plan and execute a drug raid.

A+ Many 9-1-1 telecommunicators in the United States may not have training or experience handling suicidal callers. They may develop their techniques while on the job through trial-and-error, but not have the benefit of formal training. This training course will enable you to benefit from others' experiences in handling a suicidal caller. This course dispels common suicide myths, teaches you how to assess the risk of a possible suicide call, and demonstrates proper techniques for handling that call.
