A+	Roll Call: Crime Scene Response and Protection	057-0508	30 minute video plus course materials	The responding officer has many considerations when responding to a violent crime call. Officer safety is foremost, followed by victim, witness, and bystander safety. After safety issues, protection of the crime scene becomes a primary task. This course reinforces these safety lessons and helps make the officer aware of his or her surroundings.
A+	Roll Call: Edler Abuse	057-0507	30 minute video plus course materials	When people see signs or evidence that something is or may be wrong, they believe, "Surely someone has seen that" or "I know that someone is already taking care of that." We often hear the phrase, "I don't want to get involved" or "I can't take care of them." Elder abuse is very difficult because we are dealing with adults who can make choices and decisions. Elder abuse is an important topic for peace officers. They should be able to recognize elder abuse, the various types of abuse, possible signs of abuse, and the police response to elder abuse.
A+	Talk and Be Safe	111-0507	30 minute video plus course materials	A professional law enforcement officer must deal with many different types of personalities in many stressful situations. The communication process, if handled correctly, can make all the difference in dealing with individuals in the line of duty and can mean the difference between life and death. This course discusses the communication process, which includes effective listening skills. Contained within these discussions are the importance of nonverbal communication and the assertion process that aids in the compliance of subjects through communication skills.
A+	Tactical Thinking: Traffic Stops	111-0002	30 minute video plus course materials	Tactical thinking education and drills provide officers a safe environment in which to think critically through scenarios. Practicing tactical thinking is essential to officer safety and provides experiences for the officer to draw upon during a real-life situation. This course discusses tactical thinking and how it relates to the procedures for conducting a traffic stop. Traffic stops may be a routine procedure, but officers should never treat them as such.
A+	Wilderness Series, Part 1: Patrolling Techniques	179-0152	30 minute video plus course materials	This course explores tactical movement as it relates to closing with suspects or objective sites in various types of terrain other than urban environments.
A+	Media Savvy, Part 1	164-0005	30 minute video plus course materials	At worst, the fire service and law enforcement agencies experience a hate-hate relationship with the news media that can hamper fire and crime-fighting efforts and keep the public from knowing information it needs to know or has a right to know. At best, healthy relationships between media and police and fire departments can result in accurate news coverage and positive public sentiment. This course explains what reporters are looking for and ways you can give information without giving away confidential information.
A+	Police Response to Structure Fires	057-0308	30 minute video plus course materials	This course is designed to teach both police officers and their supervisors how to respond to working structure fires. The course discusses the proper considerations for vehicle placement, actions needed, and information required to fully assist fire personnel in achieving life safety and property preservation activities.
A+	Roll Call: Police Use of Force, Part 2	057-0506	30 minute video plus course materials	This activity, the second in a three-part use of force series, will identify how to make a proper restraint as well as medical issues and concerns
A+	Roll Call: Police Use of Force, Part 3	057-0606	30 minute video plus course materials	This course explores conductive energy devices as substitutions for other compliance tactics as well as identifies causes of in-custody deaths and less-lethal weapon alternatives. The issue of conductive energy device usage recommendations is also discussed.
A+	DigitalCrime: Hackers, Part 1	152-0008	30 minute video plus course materials	Regardless of our understanding of law, hackers will act based on their understanding of the appropriate behavior. This course introduces the world of hackers by looking at several issues of importance to hackers themselves. This sknowledge can help investigators predict, understand, and communicate with members of the digital underground.
A+	Mentoring Skills	111-1007	30 minute video plus course materials	This course discusses what mentoring is from a law enforcement perspective and how critical mentorin is to the development of new law enforcement officers. The importance of leadership skills required of supervisors is discussed, as well as how supervisors can help to motivate subordinate officers in order to improve their performance. Additionally, steps that supervisors may take to correct those behaviors are explained.
