Tactical Edged Weapon Defense**

The edged weapon attack that is a problem and has no simple solution is the one that is initiated without much warning after an officer has placed himself or herself in close proximity to an offender during a vehicle stop, a frisk, an arrest, or a foot chase. Officers need to recognize the threat, respond to a sudden aggressive arm motion, and gain positional and tactical advantage.

Increasingly, law enforcement officials find themselves becoming "Internet police" in efforts to control the proliferation of child pornography. This course overviews the nature of the problem of child pornography, the extent of the problem, the effects of child pornography, and law enforcement efforts to combat child pornography.

**Sex Crimes, Part 2: Child Molestation**

In part two of our series on sex crimes, LETN explores the nature and dynamics of child molestation and exploitation. This course takes you for a ride with the U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement and the Fort Worth, Texas, Police Department as they share how their agencies are successfully prosecuting sex offenders. Our presentation also reviews the dynamics of these offenses and explores the tactics used by the offenders in order to enlighten the viewer about the nature of these types of crimes.

**Infectious Diseases**

If you were first to arrive at a medical scene, would you be prepared to give first aid? This course was designed to provide you with a basic understanding of medical conditions and procedures you may encounter in the field. Specifically, this course discusses infectious diseases, learning how to recognize the threat, when and how to use barrier protection, and what to do if you think you have been infected.
