At crime scenes, it is frequently necessary to be able to rapidly produce elimination impressions of footwear and/or tires so that time is not wasted documenting and recovering impressions that have no evidentiary value. It is also important to be able to produce test impressions of tires and footwear in a manner that ensures that the maximum possible detail is transferred. This maximizes the potential for identification of evidence impressions recovered at the scene that will be compared to the tests.
