Every year, officers are shot and killed in the line of duty. In an effort to reduce the number of deaths that occur, it is necessary to examine the deadly circumstances surrounding past incidents. This course will discuss the statistics surrounding officer shooting situations and identify factors that are common to deadly incidents. Tactical thinking and mental conditioning will be discussed, as well as how officers can better train for a possible shooting incident using "cover and concealment" and "instinctive shooting." Finally, we will address concerns for officers who have been involved in a shooting incident.
